

California Proposition 65 Compliance Letter

The State of California's Proposition 65, the Safe Drinking Water and Toxic Enforcement Act, became law in November 1986. Effective August 2018, Proposition 65 has updated labeling requirements for businesses to notify consumers with "clear and reasonable" warnings of potentially hazardous chemicals present in products. Warning labels are required on all products that contain chemicals found on the state's list of over 900 compounds and must specify that the product contains chemicals "known to the State of California to cause cancer and birth defects or other reproductive harm."

Anord Mardix (USA) Incorporated's suppliers are required to ensure that the purchase of raw materials will meet Proposition 65 standards. Suppliers are also required to continually review the list of chemicals and update both literature and product packaging to comply with current regulations. In the event Anord Mardix (USA) Inc. determines that a supplier has failed to develop and implement reasonable steps to comply with this policy, Anord Mardix (USA) Inc. reserves the right to take appropriate actions. These actions may include dissolving the business relationship with the noncompliant supplier.
